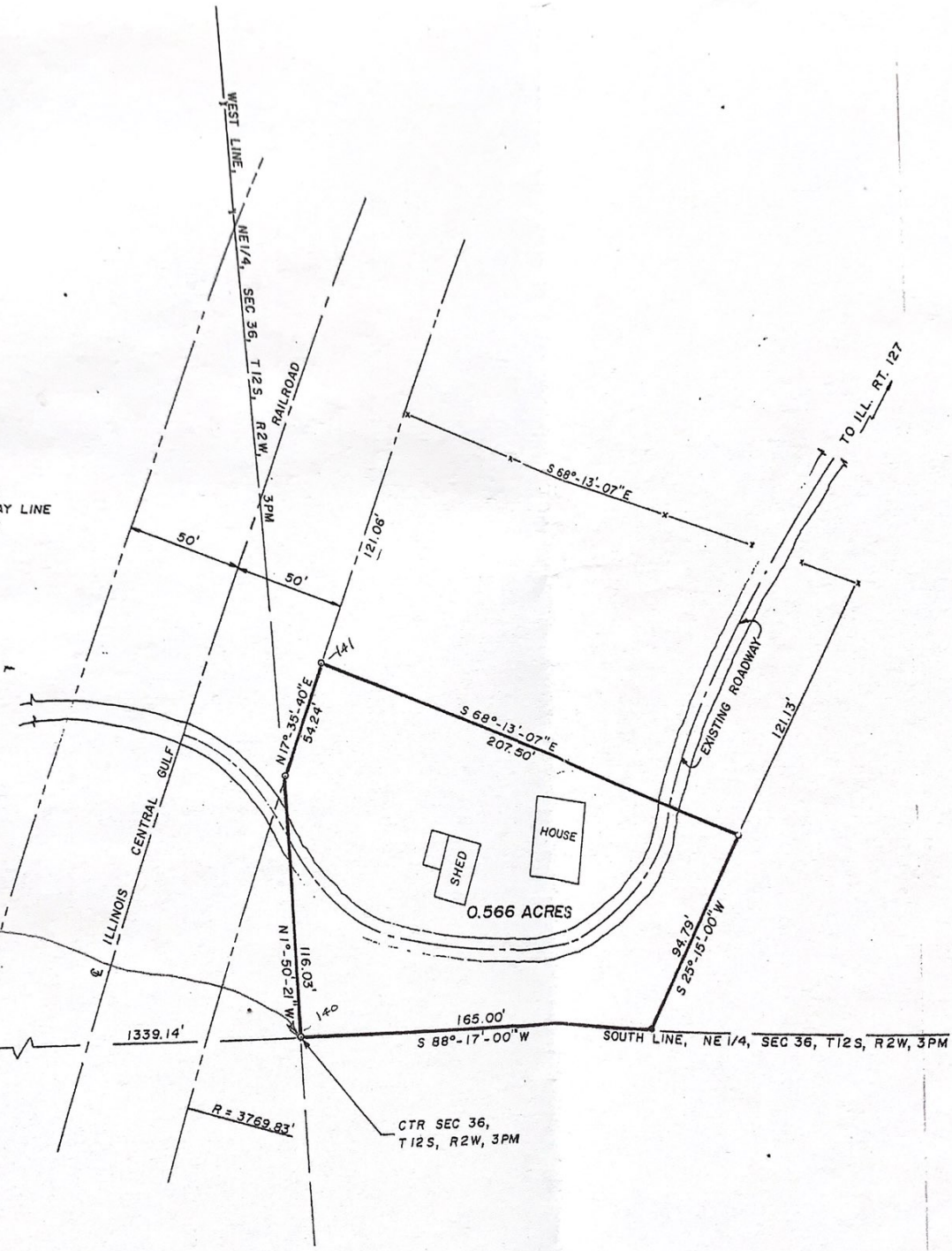

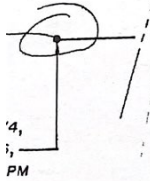

I, Charles L. Garner, Illinois Registered Land Surveyor No. 2316, do hereby certify that on May 29 and June 1, 1979, at the request of Ruth Newman, I surveyed the following tract or parcel of land:

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Situated in and a part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 36, Township 12 South, Range 2 West of the Third Principal Meridian, Union County, Illinois.

DETAIL DESCRIPTION

Beginning at the Center of Section 36, Township 12 South, Range 2 West of the Third Principal Meridian; thence North 1°-50'-21" West along the West line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 36 a distance of 116.03 feet to the Easterly Right-of-Way line of the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad; thence along the said Railroad Right-of-Way line on a curve to the right of radius 3769.83 feet a distance along the arc of 54.24 feet, the long chord of said curve being 54.24 feet long and bearing North 17°-35'-40" East; thence South 68°-13'-07" East a distance of 207.50 feet; thence South 25°-15'-00" West a distance of 94.79 feet to the South line of the said Northeast Quarter; thence South 88°-17'-00" West along the said South line a distance of 165.00 feet to the point of beginning; the tract containing 0.566 acres more or less.
